- 5. Referring to v17, what is the Old Testament understanding of the title, *Messiah* (Mashiach in Hebrew)?
- 6. In the New Testament, when the *writers refer to Jesus as 'Jesus the Messiah' or 'Jesus the Christ'* (same title in Greek) what are they saying about Jesus?
- 7. In verse 19, Joseph is clearly conflicted why?
- 8. In verse 20, what do you think of how the Lord communicates with Joseph?
- 9. In verses 20-21, what is the meaning of the name *Jesus*? And why is this name uniquely appropriate to this *Jesus the Messiah*?
- 10. In verses 24-25, what do you think of how Joseph responds to his dream?
- 11. How is God speaking to you this Advent?
- 12. What is God saying to you this Advent?
- 13. How will you respond to God's word?
