## Read Hebrews 2.14-18, Hebrews 8.6, Hebrews 9.14-15

3. How do you feel about Jesus being your mediator in God's throne room?

## Please read 1 John 2.1-2, Hebrews 4.15-16, Hebrews 12.22-29

- 4. These passages show us we are to approach the throne of God with CONFIDENCE and with REVERENCE. Which of these two approaches do you find easiest and why?
- 5. What tends to stop you approaching the throne room in prayer at all? We looked at a few ideas: a bad attitude to God, ourselves or others, sin, a reluctance to be exposed before God....
- 6. Doing business with God in His throne room needs us to move out of our comfort zone and toward Him with trust (not taking our baggage into the throne room and back out with us). How are you doing at 'doing business with God'?
