- 6. Given his priestly experience and knowledge of scripture, it's likely that Zechariah deduced that the 'person' who suddenly appeared beside the altar of incense was an angel of the Lord why do you think he was gripped with fear?

7. What do you think of how the angel speaks with Zechariah, and what he reveals to Zechariah?

Please read Luke 1.18-25

- 8. Despite his years of priestly experience, Zechariah lacks belief in the message from the messenger of God. Zechariah was guilty of questioning God God's message was only believable if it was understandable to Zechariah. Can you relate to this tendency?
- 9. Gabriel doesn't attempt to answer Zechariah's question and doubts with an explanation of how God would do what He promised he simply says, I am from God, and this is God's message...end of. Why does that answer any questions of unbelief?
- 10. Why do you think Zechariah's ability to speak was disabled by the angel?
- 11. It was Elizabeth who became the immediate bearer of the good news to others. Does this highlight a link between our belief (or lack of belief) and our participation (or limited participation) in the work of God's Kingdom?

12. Zechariah's voice and participation is restored and He worship's God. Why is this an encouragement to us all?
